Credit Card Conversion

Key Transition Dates

Saturday, August 23

Stop using your current credit card by the end of the day

Sunday, August 24

Activate your new card by calling the number on the sticker and begin using it

Monday, August 25

Access your updated online account to manage your new card

What You Need to Do

- 1. Activate your new card starting Sunday, August 24
- **2. Review and update**, if necessary, your card information for all automatic payments and online services
- Securely destroy your old card after confirming your new one is working properly



Why am I receiving a new credit card?

We're updating our card program to provide enhanced security, better service, and an improved rewards experience. Your current card will be replaced with a new NCPD FCU Visa® Credit Card.

Will my card number change?

Yes. Your new card will have a different number. Please review and update, if necessary, any automatic payments or subscriptions once your new card is activated.

Any co-borrower/authorized user will receive a new unique card number. Each card will have to be activated separately.

What happens to my current card?

Your current card will no longer work **after Saturday, August 23**. Please activate your new card on **Sunday, August 24**, and securely destroy your old one.

Will my rewards points carry over?

Yes. All existing rewards points will be posted to your account by the end of August. You can start redeeming them on September 1.

Will my interest rate or terms change?

No. Your current terms, interest rate, and credit limit will remain the same. For full details, visit ncpdfcu.org or refer to your disclosure materials.

Do I need to reapply?

No. This is an automatic card replacement. No reapplication is required.

Will this affect my credit score?

No. This is not a new application and will not impact your credit score.

When will my new card arrive?

Your new NCPD FCU Visa Credit Card® should arrive by mid-August. Activation instructions will be included.

What do I need to do when I receive it?

Activate your new card **on or after Sunday, August 24**. Then, review and update your recurring payments if necessary, and start using your new card.

Who can I contact if I have guestions?

What if I don't receive my card by August 18?

If your card hasn't arrived by then, call the Plainview office at **516-938-0300** or the Mineola office at **516-938-3339** for assistance.

How can I view my new card information?

Access to your new credit card will be through NCPD FCU online banking. Please re-enroll in eStatements and set up recurring payments.

What if I'm on vacation (or not home) to receive my card?

Please contact the Plainview office at **516-938-0300** to ensure you receive your card in a timely manner.

Family Fun With NCPD


NCPD FCU connected with law enforcement families at the Nassau County Police
