Outsmart Smishing Scammers and Keep Your Phone Secure



Texting is quick and convenient—but it's also a growing tool for scammers. Smishing (SMS phishing) is on the rise. Knowing how it works helps protect your personal information.



What Is a Smishing Text Message Scam?

Smishing uses text messages to trick victims. Scammers pose as trusted sources and use urgent language to create panic. Messages may mention a bank issue, suspicious login, or missed delivery, and include a link to a fake site made to steal your data, install malware, or get you to send money.

Tips for Protecting Yourself

- Don't click on links from unknown senders. If it seems legit, contact the company directly using a verified number or website.
- **Be wary of urgency.** Scammers try to make you act fast. Pause and think before responding.
- Never share personal information. Don't reply to texts that ask for Social Security numbers, banking details, or passwords.
- **Verify the sender.** Reach out using official contact info to confirm suspicious messages.
- Block spam and install security software. Block threats with spam filters and trusted security apps.

If You've Been Scammed

- **Contact us.** Let us know if your account was compromised or you paid a scammer.
- Report the scam to the FTC. Visit
 ReportFraud.FTC.gov and notify local law
 enforcement.
- Report to your state attorney general. Find contact info at naag.org.
- Change your passwords. Update login details for any affected accounts—especially banking, email, and social media.
- Monitor your accounts. Check your phone bill and bank statements for unauthorized activity and report anything suspicious.
